Mr. Carlo Borghini was appointed EDA Corporate Services Director on July 2014. Reporting to the Chief Executive, he is responsible for the overall management of financial and human resources, as well as administrative issues.

Previously, Mr. Borghini held the position of Deputy Executive Director for the SESAR Joint Undertaking (SJU) in Brussels from 2008 to 2014. In this capacity, he had specific responsibilities for corporate governance, administration and finance. More specifically, he managed a budget amounting to over €2 billion, with a portfolio of more than 300 different projects undertaken by the 16 SJU Members.

Prior to that, Mr. Borghini was Director and Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), a specialised Agency of the United Nations based in Roma, Italy. In this position he managed an annual budget of about \$200 million, with an overall portfolio of around \$9 billion of ongoing loans .

From 2005 to 2006, Carlo Borghini worked at the European Commission's DG BUDG Directorate General as Head of Internal Audit Unit. As such, he managed an internal auditing and consulting activity while supervising and guiding internal audit unit staff. From 2001 to 2005, he assumed the position of Internal Audit Supervisor for another Directorate General of the European Commission, DG AGRI.

Before he joined the EU institutions, Mr. Borghini held several finance-related positions in the private sector. From 1999 to 2001, he worked as Director, CFO and Country Controller for the American Express Bank in Luxembourg. From 1997 to 1999, he was Director Financial Controller for Sopaf Group in Milano, Italy.

Born on 1 September 1964 in Italy, Mr. Borghini holds a Master Degree equivalent in Business Economics. He is a native speaker of Italian and also possesses an excellent proficiency in French. He is married with three children.
