

## Event at a Glance

### WHY?

EDA in partnership with Ireland's Presidency of the Council of the EU is organising Resilient Threat Management 2013, an Event that aims to:

- Create a common understanding and appreciation of the challenges posed by IEDs past and present
- Establish a vision for how the IED threat will be managed in the future, particularly in the context of other types of threats, both asymmetric and conventional
- Generate the will to address these challenges comprehensively by bringing together international actors from the civil and military domain –
- Deliver the results of EDA efforts so far, in particular with regard to the lessons identified from the TEL(D) Project
- Spread awareness on future capability requirements and technological opportunities
- Increase networking within the community

### WHERE AND WHEN?

The Event will take place in Brussels, Belgium 4 – 6 March 2013. The first two days of the Event will be held at EDA and the final day will take place at the Royal Military Academy.

### How?

The Event will include three elements:

- A Government-only seminar dedicated to Exploitation; the lessons identified TEL(D) project in particular and the way ahead
- An Expert Conference addressing the future global context and evolution of threats along with papers being presented tackling areas such as capability development, threat detection, threat mitigation, exploitation and training
- A High Level Conference exposing the visions of senior decision makers on threat management beyond 2020 and building of strategic partnerships to ensure civil-military preparedness for the future
