

## PRIVACY STATEMENT

for the processing operation related to the PESCO Common Workspace (CWS)

<b>1. INTRODUCTION</b>
<p>This Privacy Statement describes the measures taken to protect your personal data with regard to the action involving the present data processing operation and what rights you have as a data subject.</p> <p>EDA protects the fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons and in particular their right to privacy with respect to the processing of personal data (Article 1.1 of Regulation 2018/1725).</p>

<b>3. PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING</b>
<p>The PESCO Common Workspace (CWS) is a web-based tool designed to support participating Member States in sharing information on PESCO Projects and Project Proposals. The Application is restricted to governmental users representing PESCO participating Member States and to governmental authorities representing the PESCO Secretariat.</p> <p>Personal data are processed in order to allow participation and to provide information to the PESCO CWS user community.</p>
<b>4. DATA PROCESSED</b>
<p>Data processed are the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- personal data provided by the data subject on a voluntary basis (e.g. name, function, contact details)</li><li>- no sensitive data is involved in this processing.</li></ul>
<b>5. RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA</b>
<p>The internal recipients of the data are the PESCO Unit, the Cooperation Planning Unit, the IT Unit and other EDA Units involved in a specific project.</p> <p>The information will not be communicated to third parties without your express consent.</p> <p>Registered users have access to name and contact details of other users in order to serve the purpose of facilitating the exchange.</p>

<b>6. PROTECTION AND SAFEGUARDING OF THE DATA</b>
Data is processed in accordance with the high security standards established by EDA. Personal data within the EDA network is restricted so that only PESCO secretariat staff can access, as relevant.
<b>7. RIGHT OF ACCESS AND RECTIFICATION OF THE DATA</b>
As a data subject you have the right to access your personal data and the right to correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal data, as well as to request the removal of your personal data, which will be implemented within one working day after the request has been deemed legitimate. <b>8. TIME LIMIT FOR STORING DATA</b>
Data will be kept for the duration of the project for which they have been gathered or until the data subject indicates that he/she wants the data to be removed. If not needed anymore, the data will be deleted within one month.
<b>9. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING OPERATION</b>
The legal bases for the data processing are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Article 5(a) of Regulation 2018/1725</li> <li>- Article 31 of Council Decision (CFSP) 2015/1835 of 12 October 2015 defining the statute, seat and operational rules of the European Defence Agency</li> <li>- COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2017/2315 of 11 December 2017 establishing Permanent Structured Cooperation (PESCO) and determining the list of Participating Member States,</li> <li>- COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2018/340 of 06 March 2018 establishing the list of projects to be developed under PESCO, COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2018/909 of 25 June 2018 establishing a common set of governance rules for PESCO projects</li> </ul>
