"The Satellite Centre shall, in coherence with the European Security Strategy, support the decision-making of the **European Union in the field of the** CFSP, in particular of the ESDP, including European Union crisis management operations, by providing, as appropriate, products resulting from the analysis of satellite imagery and collateral data, including aerial imagery, and related services."



### Hijacked Merchant Ships off the Coast of Somalia **EUFOR ATALANTA**

merchant ships are observed off the coast of Somalia, SE of the pirate base at Hobyo Town. he ships are identified as the general cargo ship Charelle, the bulk carrier MV Ariana and bulk carrier Xin Ha

Hobyo town is ideally suited to support pirate activities and continues to provide basic accommodation for pirates, shelter for pirate vessels and access to the Indian Ocean. The presence of three hijacked vessels off the coast Hobyo indicates that the town and its adiacent coastline is a major holding area for hijacked vessels and crews

### JA Art. 3: Political Supervision

The Political and Security Committee (PSC) will, in accordance with its responsibilities for CFSP and in particular for the ESDP, exercise political supervision over the activities of the Centre and issue guidance to the Secretary-General / High Representative on the Centre's priorities.




### JA Art. 4: Operational direction








### Total Skiff Density Study - Somalia



# Search for Potential Pirate Camps – 3D Views of the Coastline










### GMES in Operation: Damage Assessment Port-Au-Prince







### GMES activation timeline for Haiti earthquake






## **EUSC** development outlook

- Kiruna debate (Board discussion about EUSC strategy in 3/2009)
- Prepare EUSC to satisfy growing user demands determined by expanding EU's foreign and security policy agenda, by e.g.:
  - o Optimizing EU intelligence cycle and data fusion capabilities, esp. related to the European External Action Service (EEAS)
  - o Assessing and <u>updating EUSC governance model</u> to intensify interaction with PSC as well as Member States
  - o <u>Simplifying tasking process</u> to improve responsiveness to operational needs as well as high-level political decision making
  - o Assessing EUSC role within security dimension of Global Monitoring for Environment and Security programme (GMES)

The EEAS opens new opportunities for EUSC support to its civilian and military needs by improving direct interaction with PSC / Member States and EU missions and operations
